MINUTES APRIL 9, 2018

The Rutland County Democratic Executive Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Julian, in the meeting room of Ann Clark, Ltd. Attendees: Julian Fenn, Kathy Hall, Cedelle Sirjane, Eugenia Cooke, Elisabeth Filskov, Mary Droege and Heather Juliussen-Stevenson.

Kathy and Julian to begin making initial inquiries to find campaign headquarters.

Going forward, Heather to bring the name tags and markers for Democratic Party Meetings. Kathy to take sign-in list following meetings to update contact list. Eugenia to oversee sign-in during the meetings. All attendees will be asked to sign-in regardless of whether their contact information has changed; they only have to fill in the contact information if their information has changed.

Kathy to update the check-in list for voting delegates.

The Executive Committee to send upcoming events to Heather by Wednesday April 11, 2018. Heather to send email with announcements to Cedelle for distribution by Monday, April 16, 2018. Going forward, we will attempt to send events to Heather by the 10th of the month for distribution by Cedelle by the 16th.

Wallingford, Castleton and Fair Haven have Memorial Day parades. Heather to create posters with the Rutland County Democratic Party logos so that we can make our presence more visible at these events. The Executive Committee to look for people to participate in the parades. Same for the July 4th parades.

Heather to look into getting t-shirts printed up with the Rutland County Democrats so that we can make our presence visible at events.

The Executive Committee to look into "charitable" events that we can participate in.

Heather to take over the food management at the meetings.
